



1. That I am a *File Supervisor* in the Records Services Branch, Office of Records, Headquarters, of the Immigration and Naturalization Service, United States Department of Justice, and by virtue of the authority contained in Section 290(d) of the Immigration and Nationality Act and 8 CFR 103.7(d)(4), I am authorized to certify the nonexistence in the records of the Service of an official file, document, or record pertaining to a specified person or subject.
2. The Headquarters of the Immigration and Naturalization Service maintains centralized records relating to immigrant aliens who arrived after June 30, 1924, to nonimmigrant aliens who arrived on or after June 30, 1948, and a centralized index of all persons naturalized on or after September 27, 1906.
3. That after diligent search no record is found to exist in the records of the Immigration and Naturalization Service. *The search included a review of the Service's automated and nonautomated records systems. SYNOPSIS

DEFENDANT is a native and citizen of Mexico who was located within the Eastern District of Washington on May 24, 2000 while incarcerated in the Chelan Co. Regional Jail in Wenatchee. I&NS Wenatchee had been in contact with DEFENDANT's probation officer, who issued a warrant for several probation violations. DEFENDANT was arrested in the Aberdeen/Hoquiam area, where he had been working, and transported to Wenatchee and incarcerated. Upon initial I&NS contact he was provided a Spanish language version of the standard I&NS Miranda warning, Form I-214, and he waived by signature, his right to refuse questions and have consultation with an attorney before questioning.

DEFENANT admitted to having been last deported from the U.S. at Calexico, California on 02/22/1995, and to last entering the U.S. around the first of March 2000, without inspection. He claimed to have paid a smuggler \$400.00 to assist with illegal entry at San Ysidro, California, and passage to the Los Angeles area. He stated that he traveled to the Aberdeen area approx. one month ago, where he found work in a fish processing plant for \$6.50 per hour.

The most recent was DEFENDANT's third deportation, the first two being on 04/30/1994 at Otay Mesa, CA, and on 10/21/1994 at Calexico, CA. He has an extensive criminal history, with felony convictions for Larceny, in Platte, Co. Wyoming, for which he was sentenced to one year imprisonment; and two convictions in Okanogan Co. Washington, one for Burglary II, for which he was sentenced to sixty days, and Possession of Over 40 grams of Marijuana in which he received 21 days. An additional drug conviction in King Co. Washington in noted in his NCIC report, but no sentencing length is provided. DEFENDANT has misdemeanor convictions for Third Degree Theft, No Valid Driver's License, and numerous probation violations. He has arrests in Colorado, with no disposition given, for Possession of Marijuana, Trespassing, and Dangerous Drug Possession. Attempts to clarify the DEFENDANT's true criminal history and obtain conviction documents continues.
